Who We Are

The FBIMCAAA consists of business and community leaders who have completed the FBI Citizens Academy Program and work in partnership with the FBI to create contacts and channels for working with the public to share safety information.

What We Do

The FBIMCAAA creates and strengthens relationships locally and nationally with individuals, businesses, non-profits, and religious and civic groups to build key contacts within our organization and communities. These relationships have produced a host of educational and crime prevention programs to protect (1) residents and families from fraud and cyber predators; (2) businesses from hackers and economic espionage; (3) schools and workplaces from violence and illegal drugs; and (4) all citizens from potential acts of terrorism.

Community Outreach Efforts

The FBIMCAAA has a strong partnership with the FBI Milwaukee Division. The FBIMCAAA is a non-profit organization separate and apart from the FBI, but we assist the FBI with their outreach efforts in furtherance of their mission. In Milwaukee, we participate in and support the following FBI Programs:

- Citizens Academy: The Citizens Academy program is an engaging six-to-eight-week
 programs that give business, religious, civic, and community leaders an inside look at the
 FBI. Candidates are nominated by FBI employees, former Citizens Academy graduates,
 and community leaders. Participants are selected by the special agent in charge of the
 local FBI field office.
- 2. **Teen Experience and Mentorship (TEAM):** TEAM is designed for high school students, presented by the FBI Milwaukee Division and the FBIMCAAA. Thirty students from across Wisconsin, receive the opportunity to gain knowledge about local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies and their practices. The FBIMCAAA sponsors the TEAM program by providing meals, snacks, and uniform polo shirts for each of the students.
- 3. **Adopt-A-School:** Each year the Milwaukee Division works with a local school district to partner with a middle school program, primarily in at-risk communities. FBI agents and professional staff present age and grade-level appropriate FBI interactive presentations to junior high school students interested in law enforcement careers. The goal of the

program is to provide positive interaction and opportunities for teenagers in at-risk communities and encourage them to make good choices for their future.

4. **FBI Outreach to College** & University Students (FOCUS): FBI Milwaukee has partnered with the University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee (UWM) to begin a new college outreach program for UWM students. FOCUS has been designed in accord with our flagship Citizen's Academy Program. The program started in September 2022 and will run through Spring 2023 (2022-2023 academic school year).

Membership Benefits

In addition to FBI community outreach efforts, the FBIMCAAA facilitates special engagements and events for its members. We work with the FBI Milwaukee Division to arrange special local behind-the-scenes opportunities and tours for its members, invitation-only speaking engagements, Alumni Range Day (Spring), and annual visits to the FBI Headquarters in Washington, D.C. and the FBI National Training Academy at Quantico in Virginia.
